## Quantified Modal Logic and Ibn-Sina

In Quantified Modal Logic, there are four fundamental theses with significant ontological consequences. Of these theses, which have been the center of much discussions since 1950's, two are attributed to the French philosopher Jean Buridan (1300-1358) and the other two to the contemporary American philosopher Ruth Barcan. But as history has it, it can be shown that all these theses were anticipated by Ibn-Sina (980-1037). The paper is both historical and expositional.
